

Hire conditions

User instructions and agreement

Our company cannot accept responsibility for any damage or injury to anyone using the equipment however caused. Persons using the Inflatable do so at their own risk. These guidelines are for the safety of all people using the Inflatable and it is the sole responsibility of the hirer to ensure that they are fully adhered to at all times.

1. No adult should use any equipment that is supplied solely for children's use. A Child bouncy castle has an age limit of 12 years. Adults WILL damage the unit and the hirer will be liable for all damage caused.
2. No food, drinks or chewing gum to be allowed on or near the inflatable which will avoid choking and any mess. Please note that if the inflatable is collected in a dirty condition, then the person/organisation hiring it will incur a cleaning charge.
3. The inflatable device must be secured to the ground at all times. The device must never be repositioned except by Hillside Bouncy Castle staff.
4. All shoes, glasses, jewellery, badges etc, MUST be removed before using the Bouncy castle/Slide.
5. No face paints, party poppers, coloured streamers or silly string to be used wither on or near the Inflatable.
6. Climbing, hanging or sitting on the walls is DANGEROUS and must NOT be allowed.
7. A responsible adult (over 18years) must supervise the Inflatable at all times. No person under the influence of drink or drugs should supervise or operate the equipment.
8. Always ensure that the Inflatable is not overcrowded, and limit numbers according to the age and size of the children using it. Avoid large and small children using it at the same. Make sure that the children are not pushing, colliding, fighting or behaving in a manner likely to injure or cause distress to others.
9. No pets, toys or sharp instruments are to be taken onto the inflatable.
10. If the Inflatable is not being used for any part of the day, please switch the blower off at the mains.
11. Do not allow anyone to be on the Inflatable during inflation or deflation as this is DANGEROUS.
12. Do not allow anyone to bounce on the front safety step as a child could easily bounce off the Inflatable and get hurt. The step is there to assist users getting on and off!
13. Ensure that no one with a history of back or neck problems is allowed on the Inflatable, as indeed any child who is feeling unwell.
14. Please ensure that the children are not attempting somersaults, are clothed properly and that nothing can fall out of their pockets.
15. Ensure that the area around the Inflatable is kept at least 2 metres clear and that there is no hazard that may cause anyone to trip.
16. The inflatable should not be used if it becomes wet on the jumping area. If no shower cover is fitted and in the event of rain, the unit should not be used and the blower disconnected from the mains.

17. In the event of heavy rain, it is strongly recommended that the Inflatable be switched off. Any wetness on the Inflatable, including bubbling (which is normal), can be dried with a towel.
18. If wind speed exceeds 26mph the Inflatable should be deflated.
19. If the Inflatable fails for whatever reason, evacuate immediately to prevent injury.

DISCLAIMER

Please note that all persons using the Inflatable do so at their own risk.

It is the responsibility of the person/s hiring equipment to ensure that all reasonable steps are taken to avoid injury or cause damage to the equipment. In the event that damage or loss occurs, Hillside Bouncy Castles shall be entitled to recover from the Hirer the full cost of repairs (If repairs are possible at a cost less than the replacement cost of the Inflatable) or, if the Inflatable is beyond such economic repair, or is stolen, the full replacement cost of the Inflatable.

Important Notice:

Providing that the equipment is used in accordance with the guidelines and conditions of hire, those using the inflatable should do so safely. However, accidents can happen. Hillside Bouncy Castles can accept no liability for injuries sustained or any other loss, howsoever caused, in the absence of the negligence of Hillside Bouncy Castles or its employees. As the equipment will be in the hirers possession and control whilst in use rather than Hillside Bouncy Castles, any liability for injuries or other losses caused other than in the circumstances described above rests with the hirer. Accordingly, it is recommended that the hirer had adequate public liability insurance covering his or her liability arising from the use of the inflatable.

You will be required to sign a copy of the disclaimer upon delivery of the inflatable.
